The City of Burlingame has adopted a Bicycle Transportation Plan – a policy document which provides guidance for future bicycle improvements and programs. A subcommittee of the Traffic, Safety and Parking Commission and the Planning Commission worked with City staff to prepare the Plan, which was adopted by the City Council on October 18, 2004.

The Bicycle Transportation Plan is an amendment to the Circulation Element of the General Plan. The plan was recently certified by the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) and accepted by Caltrans. With a certified bicycle plan, the City becomes eligible for certain State and Federal funding for bicycle projects.
